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BUSINESS LAW SECTION STATE BAR OF TEXAS TEXAS LEGISLATIVE UPDATE February 27, 2015

The Republican leadership this week showed an intent to follow up on promises to cut taxes through measures decreasing both property and franchise taxes. Lt. Governor Dan Patrick and Senate Finance Chair Jane Nelson announced that the chamber's plan would cut taxes by \$4.6 billion, by a combination of property and business tax slashes. The plan would increase the homestead exemption to 25 percent (incorporating future adjustments based on median home values), a permanent franchise tax reduction of 15 percent, as well as lifting the franchise tax exemption from \$1 million in revenue to \$4 million. The Senate Finance Committee intends to hear tax-related bills next week.

The BLS is tracking legislation in ten (10) general subject-matter categories. Periodic updates will come in two parts, the first part, below, is a summary of the categories. The second part contains a detailed list of all bills being tracked within the categories.

A -- Section Prepared Bills

Bills in this category are proposed by the Texas Business Law Foundation ("TBLF"). The TBLF's suggested support legislative package includes legislation in the following areas:

Business Organization Code – Corporations

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting corporations and fundamental business transactions developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee. The legislation remains in the TLC formatting stage.

Business Organization Code – Partnerships and LLCs

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting partnerships and limited liabilities companies developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee. The TLC filing packet was received and bills will be filed in the House by Rep. Oliviera and in the Senate by Sen. Eltife.

Uniform Commercial Code

Modifies the definition of a "person" to include a "particular series of an entity" in Chapter 1 of the Business and Commerce Code. The legislation remains in the TLC formatting stage.

B -- Business Courts

Chancery Court

<u>HB 1603</u> (VIIIalba) – Creates a chancery court system in Texas to handle specific business litigation. Discussions with prospective Senate sponsors continue.

C -- Business Entities

LLCs Charging Order

<u>SB 433</u> (Burton) – Amends the BOC code to make section 101.112, relating to member's membership interest subject to a charging order, applicable to both single-member limited liability companies and multiple-member limited liability companies.

Business Trusts

Rep. Gary Elkins has asked for TBLF assistance in drafting legislation regarding business purpose trusts. The current draft of the bill prepared by the Legislative Council would amend Section 101.003 of the Property Code to permit a settlor of an express trust to designate the trust as a "business purpose trust" in the trust instrument so that the trust can be considered a "legal organization" for all purposes. Discussions continue with Rep. Elkins.

<u>D -- UCC</u>

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

E -- Securities

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

F -- Financial Institutions

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

G -- Business Liability

Human Trafficking

<u>HB 968</u> (Hernandez) – Applies to certain legal entities under the BOC and would make a shareholder or member of an entity jointly liable under Sec. 98.002 of the Civil Practices and Remedies Code for damages arising from trafficking of a person if the shareholder or member caused or had knowledge of the entity to be used for trafficking. The bill is modeled after Section 21.223 (b) of the Business and Commerce Code regarding existing lawsuit liability for shareholders in fraud cases. The bill's sponsor has indicated a willingness to consider revisions to the language of the bill and communications continue to address concerns.

H -- Real Estate and Related Topics

Power of Attorney

We anticipate that a package of POA amendments prepared by the REPTL section will be filed. Discussions with REPTL representatives are underway.

I -- Taxation and Related Topics

Reducing business taxes is one of the top issues of the Republican leadership.

Franchise Tax

<u>SB 7</u> (Nelson)—would permanently reduce the franchise tax rate to 0.85 percent for most taxpayers and 0.425 percent for retailers and wholesalers.

<u>SB 8</u> (Schwertner)—would increase the franchise tax exemption to businesses earning \$4 million or less in total annual revenue.

Occupation Tax

<u>SB 765</u> (Eltife)—repeals the \$200 annual licensing fee imposed on a variety of occupations, including attorneys.

J -- Choice of Law

Application of Foreign and International Law

Efforts to restrict the impact in Texas courts of certain perceived repugnant foreign laws or doctrines, or so called "Anti-Sharia" laws, continue. Several bills have been filed impacting foreign judgment enforcement, and contractual choice of law and venue provisions.

<u>HB 562</u> (Leach)/ <u>SB 531</u> (Campbell)—narrows the application to marriages, suits for dissolution of a marriage and suits relating to a parent-child relationship. The House bill has been referred to the House Judiciary and Civil Jurisprudence Committee and the Senate bill has been referred to the Senate State Affairs Committee.
