BUSINESS LAW SECTION STATE BAR OF TEXAS TEXAS LEGISLATIVE UPDATE March 13, 2015

The initial phase of the session concluded on Friday as the 60-day mark passed, as did the deadline to file regular bills. Because of the log-jam of last minute filings, this report will not cover all legislation filed on Friday.

For the first time this session, the House is slated to begin hearing bills on Monday. That chamber's budget writers finished their draft of the biennial budget, which differs significantly from the budget being considered by the Senate, particularly on funding sources. The two chambers will continue to negotiate the differences as the appropriations process moves forward.

The BLS is tracking legislation in ten (10) general subject-matter categories. Periodic updates will come in two parts, the first part, below, is a summary of the categories. The second part contains a detailed list of all bills being tracked within the categories.

A -- Section Prepared Bills

Bills in this category are proposed by the Texas Business Law Foundation ("TBLF").

Business Organization Code—Corporations

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting corporations and fundamental business transactions developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

<u>HB 2142</u> (Oliviera)/<u>SB 860</u> (Eltife)—Filed in both the House and the Senate. A committee substitute with minor corrections is being prepared by TLC. Senate B&C heard SB 860 on March 10. Lori Ann Fox and Greg Odegaard testified on behalf of TBLF, and Carmen Flores appeared on behalf of the Secretary of State's office. The Attorney General's office expressed concerns with the non-profit provisions and agreed upon language will be incorporated in a committee substitute that is expected to be voted out next week.

Business Organization Code—Partnerships and LLCs

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting partnerships and limited liabilities companies developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

HB 2144 (Oliviera)/<u>SB 859</u> (Eltife)—Filed in both the House and the Senate. A committee substitute with minor corrections is being prepared by TLC. Senate B&C heard SB 859 on

March 10. Lori Ann Fox, Greg Odegaard and Carmen Flores were the witness team on this bill as well.

Uniform Commercial Code—Chapter 1

Modifies the definition of a "person" to include "particular series of a for-profit entity" in Chapter 1 of the Business and Commerce Code.

HB 3434 (Parker)/ SB 1077 (Eltife)—Filed in both the House and Senate.

B -- Business Courts

Chancery Court

<u>HB 1603</u> (Villalba) – Creates a chancery court system in Texas to handle specific business litigation. Discussions with various interested industry groups continue. Referred to Business & Industry.

C -- Business Entities

Trusts

<u>HB 3762</u> (Elkins)—Amends Section 101.003 of the Property Code to permit a settlor of an express trust to designate the trust as a "business purpose trust" in the trust instrument, so that the trust can be considered a legal organization and treated as a business trust.

<u>HB 2534</u> (Parker)/ <u>SB 875</u> (Eltife)—Enforces State Banking Commissioner regulation over "state trust companies."

LLCs Charging Order

<u>SB 433</u> (Burton) – Amends the BOC to make Section 101.112, relating to member's membership interest subject to a charging order, applicable to both single-member limited liability companies and multiple-member limited liability companies. Referred to Senate B&C.

LP & PA Filing Requirements

<u>HB 2891</u> (Otto)—Adds limited partnerships and professional associations to Comptroller public information report filing requirements currently applicable to corporations and LLCs. Provides a corresponding exemption from SOS report or statement filing requirements.

Service of Process

See HB 241 (Leach) and HB 1806 (Tinderholt) /HB 3459 (Schofield) in the tracking report.

Business Names

<u>HB 2753</u> (Villalba)—Amends Section 5.053 of the BOC to adopt a "distinguishable" business name standard rather than the current "deceptively similar" standard. Conforms to the trend in most states and the MCBA. Supported by the SOS.

<u>SB 1313</u> (Watson)—Amends section 5.053 of the BOC to permit the use of a notarized consent to avoid application of the current business name standard.

Non-profit Corporations

<u>SB 1233</u> (L. Taylor)—Adds new provisions to Chapter 22 of the BOC authorizing distributions of income to non-profit corporation members.

<u>D -- UCC</u>

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

E -- Securities

Crowdfunding

<u>HB 2580</u> (Johnson)—Requires the State Securities Board to promulgate rules regularly and facilitating online intrastate crowdfunding and provides requirements and standards.

Insider Trading by Public Officials

<u>HB 1539</u> (Meyer) –Increases criminal penalties based on threshold pecuniary gain amounts for public officials convicted of insider trading.

State Securities Board

<u>HB 2493</u> (Parker)—Provides for the status of the State Securities Board as state agency, and adds internal operating requirements and powers.

F -- Financial Institutions

Dodd-Frank

<u>HCR 26</u> (Flynn)—Requests Congress to repeal the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.

G -- Business Liability

Human Trafficking

<u>HB 968</u> (Hernandez) – Applies to certain legal entities under the BOC and would make a shareholder or member of an entity jointly liable under Sec. 98.002 of the Civil Practices and Remedies Code for damages arising from trafficking of a person if the shareholder or member caused or had knowledge of the entity to be used for trafficking. The bill is modeled after Section 21.223 (b) of the Business and Commerce Code regarding existing lawsuit liability for shareholders in fraud cases. Hernandez agreed to accept TBLF language in a committee substitute to better mirror existing state law. Heard in House Judiciary and Civil Jurisprudence on March 10 and left pending.

Shareholder Oppression

<u>HB 3168</u> (Simmons) — Amends Chapter 21 of the BOC to provide remedies for shareholder oppression in closely held corporations, apparently overturning the Supreme Court's decision in *Ritchie v. Rupe*.

H -- Real Estate and Related Topics

Power of Attorney

HB 3095 (Thompson) – The REPTL POA bill. The POA committee is reviewing the 58-page bill.

I -- Taxation and Related Topics

Reducing business taxes is a primary issue for the Republican leadership.

Franchise Tax

<u>SB 7</u> (Nelson)—Would permanently reduce the franchise tax rate to 0.85 percent for most taxpayers and 0.425 percent for retailers and wholesalers. Referred to Senate Finance and heard on March 3 and 4. Pending in committee.

<u>SB 8</u> (Schwertner)—Would increase the franchise tax exemption to businesses earning \$4 million or less in total annual revenue. Referred to Senate Finance and heard on March 3 and 4. Pending in committee.

Occupation Tax

<u>HB 2089</u> (Darby) / <u>SB 765</u> (Eltife)—Repeals the \$200 annual licensing fee imposed on a variety of occupations, including attorneys. The Senate Bill was referred to Senate Finance and was heard on March 3 and 4. TBLF registered in support of this legislation. Pending in committee.

J -- Choice of Law

Application of Foreign and International Law

Efforts to restrict the impact in Texas courts of certain perceived repugnant foreign laws or doctrines, or so called "Anti-Sharia" laws, continue. Several bills have been filed impacting foreign judgment enforcement, and contractual choice of law and venue provisions. <u>HB 562</u> (Leach)/ <u>SB 531</u> (Campbell)—Narrows the application to marriages, suits for dissolution of a marriage and suits relating to a parent-child relationship. The House bill has been referred to the House Judiciary and Civil Jurisprudence Committee and the Senate bill has been referred to the Senate State Affairs Committee.
