# BUSINESS LAW SECTION STATE BAR OF TEXAS TEXAS LEGISLATIVE UPDATE March 27, 2015

A primary objective each session is passage of the biennial state budget. This daunting task is progressing as the House plans to take up that chamber's budget plan this week.

The House's budget bill, HB 1, passed out of committee spending \$209.8 billion, \$7.7 billion more than the current two-year budget. The House will debate HB 1 on Tuesday, along with supplemental budget bills.

The Senate Finance Committee budget plan, which is still in committee, differs from the House's proposed budget on spending in public education, transportation, tax cuts and border security. Differences between the House and the Senate's budgets will ultimately be reconciled in a conference committee before going back to each chamber for final approval.

This week, the Senate passed a package of property and franchise tax relief, a top priority of the Republican leadership. The property tax relief portion is contained in SB 1 and SJR 1, which would increase the current \$15,000 homestead exemption from school district property taxes to 25 percent of the state's median home market value. SJR 1 also ensures that real property conveyances can never be taxed. The franchise tax portion, SB 7 and SB 8, permanently reduces franchise taxes by 15 percent and exempts businesses earning under \$4 million annually from paying the franchise tax. These measures now go to the House for consideration.

The BLS is tracking legislation in ten (10) general subject-matter categories. Periodic updates will come in two parts, the first part, below, is a summary of the categories. The second part contains a detailed list of all bills being tracked within the categories.

# A -- Section Prepared Bills

Bills in this category are proposed by the Texas Business Law Foundation ("TBLF"). **Business Organization Code—Corporations** 

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting corporations and fundamental business transactions developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

<u>HB 2142</u> (Oliviera)/<u>SB 860</u> (Eltife)—The committee substitute addressing minor corrections and requested non-profit amendments from the AG was heard in House B&I on Tuesday, March 24 with Byron Egan, Daryl Robertson and Lori Ann Fox testifying for TBLF and Carmen Flores for SOS. Senate B&C voted out the substitute.

#### Business Organization Code—Partnerships and LLCs

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting partnerships and limited liabilities companies developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

<u>HB 2144</u> (Oliviera)/<u>SB 859</u> (Eltife)— The committee substitute addressing minor corrections was heard in House B&I on Tuesday, March 24 with Byron Egan, Daryl Robertson and Lori Ann Fox testifying for TBLF and Carmen Flores for SOS. Senate B&C voted out the committee substitute.

#### Uniform Commercial Code—Chapter 1

Modifies the definition of a "person" to include a series LLC.

<u>HB 3434</u> (Parker)/<u>SB 1077</u> (Eltife)— House bill has been referred to B&I. Senate bill was heard in Senate B&C on Tuesday, March 24, with Karen Neeley testifying for TBLF and voted out as filed.

#### **B** -- Business Courts

#### **Chancery Court**

<u>HB 1603</u> (Villalba) – Creates a chancery court system in Texas to handle specific business litigation. B&I heard the bill on Tuesday, March 24. Byron Egan testified on behalf of the TBLF. Former Chief Justice Tom Phillips also testified in support, along with James Sullivan of King & Spalding and Brian Walters of the Walters Law Firm in Austin. Numerous entities registered in support of the bill, including various financial and business associations. Fifteen trial lawyer generated witnesses testified against the bill and are waging a strong campaign to defeat the bill. Also opposed was the Texas Association of Defense Counsel and the Family Law Foundation. The bill remains pending in committee.

#### **C** -- Business Entities

#### Trusts

<u>HB 3762</u> (Elkins)—Amends Section 101.003 of the Property Code to permit a settlor of an express trust to designate the trust as a "business purpose trust" in the trust instrument, so that the trust can be considered a legal organization and treated as a business trust. Referred to B&I.

<u>HB 2534</u> (Parker)/ <u>SB 875</u> (Eltife)—Enforces State Banking Commissioner regulation over "state trust companies." House bill was referred to Investments Committee. Senate Bill passed B&C.

#### LLCs Charging Order

<u>SB 433</u> (Burton) – Amends the BOC to make Section 101.112, relating to member's membership interest subject to a charging order, applicable to both single-member

limited liability companies and multiple-member limited liability companies. Referred to Senate B&C.

#### **LP & PA Filing Requirements**

<u>HB 2891</u> (Otto)/ <u>SB 1541</u> (Perry)—Adds limited partnerships and professional associations to Comptroller public information report filing requirements currently applicable to corporations and LLCs. Provides a corresponding exemption from SOS report or statement filing requirements. House bill referred to Ways and Means. Senate bill referred to B&C.

#### **Service of Process**

<u>HB 241</u> (Leach)—Provides a method of substituted service of citation through a "social media presence." Pending in House Judiciary.

#### **Business Names**

<u>HB 2753</u> (Villalba)—Amends Section 5.053 of the BOC to adopt a "distinguishable" business name standard rather than the current "deceptively similar" standard. Conforms to the trend in most states and the MCBA. Supported by the SOS. A committee substitute makes drafting changes and amends Section 5.102, relating to prohibitions and exceptions of reservations of certain names, and Section 5.153, relating to prohibitions and exceptions of certain registrations. Referred to B&I and set for a hearing on March 30.

<u>SB 1973</u> (V. Taylor)—Intended to be Senate companion of HB 2753, but not considered an official companion due to drafting error. Referred to B&C.

<u>SB 1313</u> (Watson)—Amends section 5.053 of the BOC to permit the use of a notarized consent to avoid application of the current business name standard. Referred to B&C.

#### **Non-profit Corporations**

<u>HB 3479</u> (Oliveira)/ <u>SB 1233</u> (L. Taylor)—Adds new provisions to Chapter 22 of the BOC authorizing distributions of income to non-profit corporation members. House bill referred to B&I. Senate bill referred to B&C.

#### <u>D -- UCC</u>

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

#### E -- Securities

#### Crowdfunding

<u>HB 1629</u> (Johnson)—Directs the State Securities Board to create crowd funding provisions for non-profits and government entities that provide small business and economic development loans. Referred to Investments and Financial Services.

<u>HB 2580</u> (Johnson)—Requires the State Securities Board to promulgate rules regularly, facilitates online intrastate crowdfunding and provides requirements and standards. Referred to Investments and Financial Services.

<u>HB 3425</u> (Parker)—Establishes intrastate exchange on which crowd funding and other federal exempted offerings could be offered. Referred to Investments and Financial Services.

# **Insider Trading by Public Officials**

<u>HB 1539</u> (Meyer)–Increases criminal penalties based on threshold pecuniary gain amounts for public officials convicted of insider trading. Referred to General Investigating and Ethics.

<u>SB 111</u> (V. Taylor)—Identical to HB 1539, but not an official companion. Referred to State Affairs.

#### **Securities Licenses**

<u>HB 2484</u> (Schaefer)—Amends Title 2 of the Occupations Code to require state agencies to waive education, training, experience and examination requirements for obtaining an occupational license if an applicant holds a substantially equivalent license in another state. Applies to securities licenses. Referred to Licensing.

<u>HB 3981</u> (Darby)—Would allow an occupational license holder the choice to have an administrative law judge at the State Office of Administrative Hearings render the final decision in a contested case instead of the head of the agency granting the occupational license. Referred to Licensing.

#### **State Securities Board**

<u>HB 2493</u> (Parker)—Provides for the SDSI status for the State Securities Board as state agency, and adds internal operating requirements and powers. Referred to Investments and Financial Services

#### **F** -- Financial Institutions

#### **Dodd-Frank**

<u>HCR 26</u> (Flynn)—Requests Congress to repeal the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. Referred to Select Committee on State and Federal Power and Responsibility.

#### **Consumer Credit Transactions Regulations**

<u>HB 3094</u> (Parker)/ <u>SB 1282</u> (Eltife)—Relates to the regulation of consumer credit transactions and the regulatory authority of the Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner. The OCCC is preparing language to address concerns with amendments to the Finance Code. House bill referred to Investments Committee. Senate bill referred to B&C.

#### **G** -- Business Liability

#### **Human Trafficking**

<u>HB 968</u> (Hernandez)/ <u>SB 1848</u> (Garcia) – Applies to certain legal entities under the BOC and would make a shareholder or member of an entity jointly liable under Sec. 98.002 of the Civil Practices and Remedies Code for damages arising from trafficking of a person if the shareholder or member caused or had knowledge of the entity to be used for trafficking. The bill is modeled after Section 21.223 (b) of the Business and Commerce Code regarding existing lawsuit liability for shareholders in fraud cases. Hernandez accepted TBLF language in a committee substitute to better mirror existing state law. House Judiciary voted out the bill as amended. Senate bill referred to State Affairs.

#### **Shareholder Oppression**

<u>HB 3168</u> (Simmons) — Amends Chapter 21 of the BOC to provide remedies for shareholder oppression in closely held corporations, apparently overturning the Supreme Court's decision in *Ritchie v. Rupe*. Referred to B&I.

#### H -- Real Estate and Related Topics

#### **Power of Attorney**

<u>HB 3095</u> (Thompson) –The REPTL POA bill. A committee substitute will contain the addition of a Certification of Power of Attorney, and clean up language regarding the termination of the agent's authority due to dissolution of marriage by divorce/annulment or being declared void. Conversations with REPTL continue. Referred to Judiciary.

#### I -- Taxation and Related Topics

Reducing business taxes is a primary issue for the Republican leadership.

#### **Property Tax**

<u>SB 1</u>/ <u>SJR 1</u> (Nelson)—Increases the homestead exemption for school district taxes from \$15,000 to 25 percent of Texas home median market value. Also ensures that real property conveyances can never be taxed. Passed the Senate.

#### **Franchise Tax**

<u>SB 7</u> (Nelson)—Would permanently reduce the franchise tax rate to 0.85 percent for most taxpayers and 0.425 percent for retailers and wholesalers and modifies the "easy file" process by increasing application from \$10 million in total revenue to \$20 million, and by lowering the calculation rate from .575% to .331%. Passed the Senate.

<u>SB 8</u> (Schwertner)—Would increase the franchise tax exemption to businesses earning \$4 million or less in total annual revenue. Passed the Senate.

#### **Occupation Tax**

<u>HB 2089</u> (Darby) / <u>SB 765</u> (Eltife)—Repeals the \$200 annual licensing fee imposed on a variety of occupations, including attorneys. House Bill was referred to Licensing and is

scheduled for a hearing on March 30. The Senate Bill is pending in Senate Finance. TBLF registered in support of this legislation.

## J -- Choice of Law

#### Application of Foreign and International Law

Efforts to restrict the impact in Texas courts of certain perceived repugnant foreign laws or doctrines continue. Several bills have been filed impacting foreign judgment enforcement, and contractual choice of law and venue provisions.

<u>HB 562</u> (Leach)/ <u>SB 531</u> (Campbell)—Narrows the application to marriages, suits for dissolution of a marriage and suits relating to a parent-child relationship. House Judiciary and Civil Jurisprudence Committee heard the bill on Tuesday, March 24. Leach indicated he will offer the TBLF proposed carve-out as a floor amendment. The Senate bill has been referred to the Senate State Affairs Committee.
