# BUSINESS LAW SECTION STATE BAR OF TEXAS TEXAS LEGISLATIVE UPDATE March 6, 2015

The Legislature welcomed three new State Representatives and one Senator this week as a result of a slew of special elections to fill seats vacated by members who sought other offices.

Former State Representative Jose Menendez (D-San Antonio) was sworn into the Senate, taking the place of Leticia Van de Putte, who resigned to run for mayor of San Antonio. She will face former State Representative Mike Villarreal, who also resigned to run for mayor. After winning the special election for Villarreal's former seat, Rep. Diego Bernal (D-San Antonio) took the oath of office in the House of Representatives, along with Rep. John Cryrier (R-Lockhart) who took the place of Tim Kleinschmidt, now at the Agriculture Commission, and Rep. Leighton Schubert (R-Caldwell), who won the special election for Senator Lois Kolkhorst's House seat. Kolkhorst (R-Brenham) ran and won the Senate seat of Comptroller Glen Hegar.

The Senate passed the first bill of the session, which addressed transportation funding by dedicating a portion of the motor vehicle sales tax to road construction and maintenance.

Discussions on tax relief continue as the Senate Finance committee held marathon hearings on more than 30 bills addressing mostly property tax relief and the franchise tax.

The 60-day cut off for bill filing is next Friday.

The BLS is tracking legislation in ten (10) general subject-matter categories. Periodic updates will come in two parts, the first part, below, is a summary of the categories. The second part contains a detailed list of all bills being tracked within the categories.

#### A -- Section Prepared Bills

Bills in this category are proposed by the Texas Business Law Foundation ("TBLF"). The TBLF's suggested support legislative package includes legislation in the following areas:

#### **Business Organization Code – Corporations**

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting corporations and fundamental business transactions developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

<u>HB 2142</u> (Oliviera)/<u>SB 860</u> (Eltife)—Filed in both the House and the Senate. A committee substitute with minor corrections is being prepared by TLC. Senate B&C is set to hear SB 860 on March 10 at 9 a.m. Lori Ann Fox and Greg Odegaard are expected to appear as witnesses on behalf of TBLF. Carmen Flores will appear on behalf of the Secretary of State's office.

#### **Business Organization Code – Partnerships and LLCs**

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting partnerships and limited liabilities companies developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

<u>HB 2144</u> (Oliviera)/<u>SB 859</u> (Eltife)—Filed in both the House and the Senate. A committee substitute with minor corrections is being prepared by TLC. Senate B&C is set to hear SB 859 on March 10 at 9 a.m. Lori Ann Fox, Greg Odegaard and Carmen Flores are expected to provide testimony on this bill as well.

#### **Uniform Commercial Code**

Modifies the definition of a "person" to include a "particular series of an entity" which, after numerous discussions with Legislative Council, will be changed to "<u>particular series of a for-profit entity</u>" in Chapter 1 of the Business and Commerce Code. The legislation should be forwarded to our sponsors and filed early next week.

#### **B** -- Business Courts

#### **Chancery Court**

<u>HB 1603</u> (VIIIalba) – Creates a chancery court system in Texas to handle specific business litigation. Discussions with various interested industry groups and with prospective Senate sponsors continue.

#### **<u>C</u>** -- Business Entities

#### LLCs Charging Order

<u>SB 433</u> (Burton) – Amends the BOC code to make section 101.112, relating to member's membership interest subject to a charging order, applicable to both single-member limited liability companies and multiple-member limited liability companies. Referred to Senate B&C.

#### **Business Trusts**

Rep. Gary Elkins has asked for TBLF assistance in drafting legislation regarding business purpose trusts. The current draft of the bill prepared by the Legislative Council would amend Section 101.003 of the Property Code to permit a settlor of an express trust to designate the trust as a "business purpose trust" in the trust instrument so that the trust can be considered a "legal organization" for all purposes. Discussions continue with Rep. Elkins.

#### <u>D -- UCC</u>

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

#### E -- Securities

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

#### **F** -- Financial Institutions

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

#### **G** -- Business Liability

#### **Human Trafficking**

<u>HB 968</u> (Hernandez) – Applies to certain legal entities under the BOC and would make a shareholder or member of an entity jointly liable under Sec. 98.002 of the Civil Practices and Remedies Code for damages arising from trafficking of a person if the shareholder or member caused or had knowledge of the entity to be used for trafficking. The bill is modeled after Section 21.223 (b) of the Business and Commerce Code regarding existing lawsuit liability for shareholders in fraud cases. Hernandez agreed to accept TBLF language in a committee substitute to better mirror existing state law. Referred to House Judiciary and Civil Jurisprudence. Hearing set for March 10.

#### H -- Real Estate and Related Topics

#### **Power of Attorney**

We anticipate that a package of POA amendments prepared by the REPTL section will be filed. Discussions with REPTL representatives continue.

#### I -- Taxation and Related Topics

Reducing business taxes is one of the top issues of the Republican leadership.

#### **Franchise Tax**

<u>SB 7</u> (Nelson)—Would permanently reduce the franchise tax rate to 0.85 percent for most taxpayers and 0.425 percent for retailers and wholesalers. Referred to Senate Finance and heard on March 3 and 4.

<u>SB 8</u> (Schwertner)—Would increase the franchise tax exemption to businesses earning \$4 million or less in total annual revenue. Referred to Senate Finance and heard on March 3 and 4.

#### **Occupation Tax**

<u>HB 2089</u> (Darby) / <u>SB 765</u> (Eltife)—Repeals the \$200 annual licensing fee imposed on a variety of occupations, including attorneys. The Senate Bill was referred to Senate Finance and was heard on March 3 and 4. TBLF registered in support of this legislation.

#### J -- Choice of Law

#### Application of Foreign and International Law

Efforts to restrict the impact in Texas courts of certain perceived repugnant foreign laws or doctrines, or so called "Anti-Sharia" laws, continue. Several bills have been filed impacting foreign judgment enforcement, and contractual choice of law and venue provisions.

<u>HB 562</u> (Leach)/ <u>SB 531</u> (Campbell)—Narrows the application to marriages, suits for dissolution of a marriage and suits relating to a parent-child relationship. The House bill has been referred to the House Judiciary and Civil Jurisprudence Committee and the Senate bill has been referred to the Senate State Affairs Committee.
