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BUSINESS LAW SECTION STATE BAR OF TEXAS TEXAS LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

February 17, 2017

Several Senate committees picked up the pace this week. The Senate State Affairs Committee took up a handful of bills, including the federal Constitutional Convention resolution, contentious abortion related bills, and one that would prevent payroll deductions for union dues. Senate Business and Commerce has not yet scheduled its first meeting.

The House Appropriations Committee commenced meetings to deliberate on the proposed \$109 billion initial House budget recommendations. As previously reported, the Comptroller has estimated \$104.87 billion in state funds available for the 2018-19 budget. The House budget writers are considering tapping the State's so called "Rainy Day Fund" to fill the gap, a move not embraced by budget conservatives or the Senate. Other House committees, although now appointed, continue to remain in the organizational stage. Bill committee referrals will now start to escalate.

Texas Business Law Foundation bills have started to flow out of the Legislative Council, and final mark-ups are underway. The TUTSA bill was actually filed in the House.

The BLS is tracking legislation in ten (10) general subject-matter categories. Periodic updates will come in two parts, the first part, below, is a summary of the categories. The second part contains a detailed list of all bills being tracked within the categories.

A -- Section Prepared Bills

Bills in this category are proposed by the Texas Business Law Foundation ("TBLF").

Business Organization Code -- Corporations and Nonprofit Associations

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee, addressing corporation, nonprofit corporation, and nonprofit association actions and matters, including share issuance, dividends, and ownership; director

voting; mergers and conversions; defective act ratification; records transparency; and notice uniformity. Bill draft remains pending in the Legislative Council. We expect the TLC draft any day. Discussions continue with Sen. Hancock and Rep. Oliveira on sponsorship.

Business Organization Code -- Partnerships and LLCs

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee, affecting partnership, limited liability company, and series LLC actions and matters, including company and partnership agreement enforceability; officer vacancies; series LLC status; liability clarification; business names; service of process; records transparency; and winding up. The TLC draft has been received and is under review by BOC drafting committee. Discussions also continue with Sen. Hancock and Rep. Oliveira on sponsorship.

Uniform Trade Secrets Act

Amendments to the TUTSA, conforming it to recent modifications to the uniform act and federal law.

<u>HB 1995</u> (Elkins) - Filed in the House, not yet referred. Senate sponsorship discussions continue.

Business Names

Adopts the "distinguishable name" standard rather than the current "deceptively similar" standard in the reservation of business names, as supported by the Secretary of State. Bill draft remains pending in the Legislative Council. Discussions continue with Sen. Watson and Rep. Villalba.

B -- Business Courts

Chancery Court

Initiative by Rep. Jason Villalba (R-Dallas) to establish a dedicated business court system in Texas to handle specified complex business litigation. Rep. Villalba continues discussions with stakeholders.

C -- Business Entities

Shareholder Oppression

Debate continues over the need to codify certain minority shareholder protections in the wake of <u>Ritchie v. Rupe</u>. During the legislative interim, the House Business and Commerce Committee studied the issue, receiving pro and con testimony. Byron Egan, on behalf of the TBLF, presented compelling testimony that adequate remedies exist under current law and that additional codification on the subject is not needed, and likely would cause harmful uncertainty in business entity organization. B&C declined to make a recommendation on the issue. Rep. Ron Simmons (R-Carrollton), the leading

proponent for action on the subject, is nonetheless considering filing another bill. No bill has yet been filed.

Ethics/Interests in Government Contracts

HB 1295 (Capriglione) - Amendment package to previous HB 1295 to clarify and simplify business entity compliance with the bill's required disclosures when contracting with a government entity. The bill increases the number of business entities exempt from the registration requirements (publicly traded entities and "direct or indirect wholly owned subsidiaries"; FDIC insured institutions; certain utilities; and insurance companies). For those entities not exempt, a number of questions regarding the extent of the registration requirements remain unanswered. Additionally, the bill re-defines several terms, including "contract," in ways that add confusion regarding the requirements and adds a civil penalty (\$500 for the first day; \$100 per day thereafter to a maximum of \$10,000) for an entity that fails to file the registration or the disclosures contained therein, enforceable by the Texas Ethics Commission or the Attorney General. These items were not included in the legislation drafted by stakeholders who worked with the author during the interim.

HB 1610 (Kuempel) - An alternative amendment package to HB 1295. This bill would apply the registration only for contracts in excess of \$10 million and simplifies the registration requirements and is likely to be favored by a number of stakeholders. Discussion will be undertaken with Rep. Kuempel to determine his expectations for the bill so the extent of TBLF support can be gauged.

Activist Shareholders

Possible initiative to impose certain restrictions on activist corporate shareholders. Communications continue with legislative leaders on whether such a bill will be filed.

Health Organization Corporations and Partnerships

<u>SB 679</u> (Hancock) - Adds chiropractors to existing authorizations for doctors of medicine, osteopathy, and podiatry to establish business entities jointly owned and controlled by those types of practitioners.

D -- UCC

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

E -- Securities

Self Funding Status for State Securities Board

<u>HB 823</u> (Parker) - Gives the State Securities Board self-directed and semi-independent status, treating it similarly to the Texas Department of Banking.

F -- Financial Institutions

Electronic Notarization

<u>HB 1217</u> (Parker) - Initiative by the Texas Mortgage Bankers Association. TBLF endorsement has been requested.

G -- Business Liability

Director Liability Following Charter Revocation

Section 171.255, Tax Code, is designed to enforce the collection of corporate taxes by the Comptroller. The tax collection tool, however, exposes directors and officers to an excessive liability for *all* corporate debts during a revocation period should taxes not be paid. *Hovel v. Batzeri*, currently on appeal the Texas Supreme Court, supports a customary and reasonable approach as to when a debt is created under the statute. Should the Court, however, overturn the *Hovel* decision, there is concern that the uncertainty and negative impact of the statute could be significantly increased. Discussion continues on the need for legislation.

H -- Real Estate and Related Topics

Power of Attorney

HB 1974 (Wray)/SB 926 (Rodriguez) - Addresses significant modifications to the durable power of attorney provisions of Chapter 751, Estates Code, including mandatory acceptance. A stakeholder meeting this week with Rep. Wray included representatives from TBLF and BLS, REPTL, and impacted financial institution associations. The meeting produced significant progress on a consensus for the bill, with, TBLF/BLS draftspersons working on language for review by REPTL attorneys and vice-versa. Rep. Wray has committed to incorporate any agreed language in a committee substitute.

I -- Taxation and Related Topics

Franchise Tax

Numerous bills pertaining to franchise tax reform and cuts have been filed.

<u>SB 17</u> (Nelson) - Provides phased reduction and ultimate elimination of the franchise tax, based on revenue growth. Of the numerous filed bills, this bill likely will be the primary vehicle for Senate action.

Property Tax

The Senate leadership has declared property tax reform and cuts as key components of its legislative priorities.

<u>SB 2</u> (Bettencourt) - Designated package for ad valorem taxation reform, including an effective 4% cap on increases (without an election).

J -- Choice of Law

Application of Foreign and International Law

Efforts to restrict the impact in Texas courts of certain perceived repugnant foreign laws or doctrines, or so called "Anti-Sharia" laws, continue. Bills could impact foreign judgment enforcement, use of foreign laws, and contractual choice of law and venue.

<u>HB 45</u> (Flynn) - Amends the Civil Practice and Remedies Code to prohibit application of foreign laws or contractual choice of law or venue provisions requiring foreign laws, if the foreign laws would violate rights under the U.S. or Texas constitutions.

<u>HB 498</u> (Fallon) - Amends the Family Code and narrows application to marriages and parent-child relationships.

SB 944 - Adopts the Uniform Foreign-Country Money Judgments Recognition Act.
