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BUSINESS LAW SECTION STATE BAR OF TEXAS TEXAS LEGISLATIVE UPDATE May 5, 2017

After weeks of a inaction on each other's bills, and a resulting backlog of bills awaiting committee referral, the House and Senate finally referred hundreds of stranded bills that have passed out of the opposite chamber. The action unleashed a flurry of committee action, creating a new backlog of bills awaiting floor consideration. To deal with the pile-up, the House has scheduled its first Saturday meeting of the session, with weekend meetings now likely for the remainder of the session.

With the strong urging of the Governor, the resolution calling for a federal constitutional convention has passed the Legislature, making Texas the 11th state to do so (34 states are needed for action). The resolution requests consideration of amendments imposing fiscal and jurisdictional restraint and congressional term limits.

After another late-night debate, the House approved the controversial "Hailstorm Bill" on Thursday. The bill would set new requirements on notices of a lawyer's intent to sue and could restrict attorneys' fees. Supporters of <u>HB 1774</u> by Greg Bonnen (R-Houston) say the measure targets "abusive" lawsuits while protecting consumers' right to sue their insurance company if it acts unfairly or in bad faith. Opponents say the legislation will benefit insurance companies by restricting business and consumer access to the courts to resolve disputes over hail and other storm claims.

After intense weekend negotiations, the Senate passed a bill aimed at overhauling the City of Houston's troubled pension funds on a surprisingly easy 25-5 vote. The bill's author Joan Huffman (R- Houston) added pension bond election requirements, which Mayor Sylvester Turner has previously described as a "poison pill". The House is scheduled to take up its version of the bill, without the poison pill, on Saturday. Houston's Firefighters Union, which opposes the bill, has lobbied strongly against its passage in the House. A close vote is expected. The BLS is tracking legislation in ten (10) general subject-matter categories. Periodic updates will come in two parts, the first part, below, is a summary of pertinent bill and issues within the categories. The second part contains a detailed list of all bills being tracked within the categories.

A -- Section Prepared Bills

Bills in this category are proposed by the Texas Business Law Foundation ("TBLF").

Business Organization Code -- Corporations and Nonprofit Associations

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee, addressing corporation, nonprofit corporation, and nonprofit association actions and matters, including share issuance, dividends, and ownership; director voting; mergers and conversions; defective act ratification; records transparency; and notice uniformity.

<u>SB 1518</u> (Hancock)/<u>HB 2827</u> (Oliveira) - The Senate bill was referred to and voted out of House B & I on 5/3 with a recommendation for an expedited calendar. The House bill previously passed out of B & I on 4/19, and is pending before the House Local & Consent Calendars Committee. The current game plan is for the Senate bill to catch up with the House bill for a House floor substitution.

Business Organization Code -- Partnerships and LLCs

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee, affecting partnership, limited liability company, and series LLC actions and matters, including company and partnership agreement enforceability; officer vacancies; series LLC status; liability clarification; business names; service of process; records transparency; and winding up.

<u>SB 1517</u> (Hancock)/<u>HB 2826</u> (Oliveira) - The Senate bill was also voted out of Business B & I on 5/3 with a recommendation for an expedited calendar. The House bill passed out of B & I on 4/19, and is pending before the House Local &Consent Calendars Committee. As with the BOC corporations bill, the game plan is for the Senate bill to catch up with the House bill for a House floor substitution.

Uniform Trade Secrets Act

Amends the TUTSA, conforming it to the federal Defend Trade Secrets Act and recent case law.

<u>SB 1945</u> (Hughes)/<u>HB 1995</u> (Elkins) - The Senate bill was heard and voted out of the State Affairs Committee on 4/20 and sent to the Senate Administration Committee for expedited floor consideration. The House bill, after passing the House, was swiftly referred directly to the Administration Committee (to replace the pending Senate version) and is now on the Intent Calendar with expectation

that it will be considered and passed by the full Senate early next week. Efforts to prepare Sen. Hughes for the floor debate are underway.

Business Names

Replaces the current business name registration standard with the "distinguishable name" standard used in most other states, as supported by the Secretary of State.

<u>SB 1835</u> (Estes) /<u>HB 2856</u> (Villalba) - The Senate bill was heard in B & C on 4/25 and left pending, in anticipation of the House bill coming over. The House bill was heard voted out of B & I on 4/17, and we expect an expedited calendar setting in the next couple of days.

B -- Business Courts

Chancery Court

<u>HB 2594</u> (Villalba) - Establishes a dedicated business court system in Texas to handle specific business litigation.

Referred to Judiciary & Civil Jurisprudence. The second stakeholder meeting was held on 4/20, with TBLF, TTLA, Judicial Council, Governor's office representatives participating. The TBLF drafting team is preparing comments to the last draft. Rep. Villalba has asked that the group reconvene on May 12th.

<u>C -- Business Entities</u>

Shareholder Oppression

Debate continues over the need to codify certain minority shareholder protections in the wake of <u>Ritchie v. Rupe</u>. During the legislative interim, the House Business and Commerce Committee studied the issue, receiving pro and con testimony. Byron Egan, on behalf of the TBLF, presented compelling testimony that adequate remedies exist under current law and that additional codification on the subject is not needed, and likely would cause harmful uncertainty in business entity organization. B & C declined to make a recommendation on the issue.

No bill filed.

Ethics/Interests in Government Contracts

<u>HB 1295</u> (Capriglione) - Amendment package to previous HB 1295 to clarify and simplify business entity compliance with the bill's required disclosures when contracting with a government entity. The bill increases the number of business entities exempt from the registration requirements (publicly traded entities and their wholly owned subsidiaries; FDIC insured institutions; certain utilities; and insurance companies). For those entities not exempt, a number of questions

regarding the extent of the registration requirements remain unanswered. Additionally, the bill re-defines several terms, including "contract," in ways that add confusion regarding the requirements and adds a civil penalty (\$500 for the first day; \$100 per day thereafter to a maximum of \$10,000) for an entity that fails to file the registration or the disclosures contained therein, enforceable by the Texas Ethics Commission or the Attorney General.

Heard in General Investigating & Ethics on 3/23 and left pending. Variations for a committee substitute continue to be discussed. Rep. Capriglione has indicated a willingness to delete the civil penalty provisions. Momentum on the bill, however, has stalled.

<u>HB 1610</u> (Kuempel) – An alternative amendment package to HB 1295. This bill would apply the registration only for contracts in excess of \$10 million and simplifies the registration requirements and is favored by a number of stakeholders.

Also heard in General Investigating & Ethics on 3/23 and left pending. The bill gained a spurt of momentum last week when proponents circulated a proposed committee substitute and requested stakeholders to weigh in with the committee. The substitute drops the trigger to \$50,000, clarifies definitions, includes a list of exemptions similar to HB 1295, and does not include penalties. The use and reporting of "intermediaries", however, presents some difficulties, but most stakeholders remain supportive. The effort did not gain traction this week.

Health Organization Corporations and Partnerships

<u>SB 679</u> (Hancock)/<u>HB 3820</u> (Dale) - Adds chiropractors to existing authorizations for doctors of medicine, osteopathy, and podiatry to establish business entities jointly owned and controlled by those types of practitioners.

The Senate bill passed the Senate 3/22. The House companion has been referred to Public Health.

Nonprofit Corporation Salary Disclosure

<u>HB 2674</u> (Uresti) - Adds Section 22.451 to the BOC, and requires nonprofits receiving 25% or more of income from state funding to file an annual report to the SOS showing employee and officer salaries.

Voted out of B & I on Monday 5/1, with modifications exempting religious organizations.

Benefit Corporations

<u>HB 3488</u> (Hinojosa) - Relating to authorizing the formation of public benefit corporations.

A committee substitute was voted favorably from the Economic & Small Business Development Committee on 4/18 and placed on General State Calendar for today 5/5. The substitute was reworked for BOC compatibility, and is acceptable to the TBLF.

Nonprofit Corporation Audits

<u>SB 2180</u> (Menéndez) - Provides an exemption for certain financial records from public inspection if a CPA has conducted an independent audit of any of the previous three fiscal years of a NPC's finances, so long as the NPC makes available to the public a copy of the audit letter and copies of its most recent three annual reports.

Referred to B & C. Menendez's staff acknowledges drafting issues with the bill, and is open to suggestions. The staff advises the bill is an effort to better direct the use of limited NPC resources.

SOS Termination of Business Entity

<u>SB 1579</u> (Garcia) - Permits SOS to terminate the existence of a domestic filing entity if a substantial owner or governing person of the entity has been convicted of human trafficking or compelling prostitution.

Referred to State Affairs. Garcia's staff acknowledges drafting issues with the bill, and is open to suggestions. The intent is to push ramifications for the criminal activity upward to businesses that might be involved.

<u>D -- UCC</u>

No bills filed.

E -- Securities

Self Funding Status for State Securities Board

<u>HB 823</u> (Parker) - Gives the State Securities Board self-directed and semiindependent status, treating it similarly to the Texas Department of Banking.

Referred to Investments & Financial Services.

Activist Shareholders

<u>SB 2206</u> (Hancock) - A significantly shortened version Chairman Parker's "Bring Business to Texas and Disclosure Act" referenced below. Similarly imposes disclosure requirements for certain "activist" investor actions.

Referred to B & C. Current communications indicate that the bill will not be heard.

<u>HB 2382</u> (Parker) - The "Bring Business to Texas and Disclosure Act". Imposes extensive disclosure requirements for certain "activist" investor actions.

Referred to Investments & Financial Services. Current communications also indicate that the Parker version will not be heard. Discussion continues on interim study options, which Chairman Parker confirms will be requested. One suggestion is to establish an advisory panel of industry experts, rather than the customary standing legislative committee undertaking, or some combination of both.

Insider Trading by Public Officials

<u>HB 1090</u> (Meyer)/<u>SB 140</u> (V. Taylor) - Graduated increase in criminal penalties based on pecuniary gain, for public officials convicted of insider trading.

Senate bill referred to State Affairs. House bill passed the House on 4/19.

F -- Financial Institutions

Electronic Notarization

<u>HB 1217</u> (Parker) - Establishes electronic notaries public. An initiative by the Texas Mortgage Bankers Association and others.

Advocates presented a committee substitute which limited the scope of the bill, to accommodate the SOS, major title companies, and the large number of comments received on the filed version. The bill is scheduled on the House Calendar for 5/5.

Texas Revised Uniform Fiduciary Access to Digital Assets

<u>SB 1193</u> (V. Taylor)/<u>HB 2158</u> (Parker) - Establishes procedures for the agreed administration of digital assets (electronic records in which individuals have rights or interests) by financial institutions. A REPTL initiative.

Senate bill referred to the Judiciary & Civil Jurisprudence on 3/21. House bill passed House on 5/1. Review by impacted BLS lawyers indicates it is a good bill.

Usury

<u>HB 2977</u> (Longoria) - Relating to methods of computing interest charges on certain consumer loans.

Referred to Investments & Financial Services.

Finance Agency Regulation

Clarifies applicable law for licensees and others operating under the Finance Code.

<u>SB 1530</u> (Estes)/<u>HB 3081</u> (Capriglione) - Relating to the regulation of persons and business activities subject to regulation by certain finance agencies.

Senate bill heard in B & C on 4/25 and left pending. House bill heard in Investments & Financial Services on 4/11 and has been placed on the General State Calendar.

Financial Exploitation

<u>SB 2067</u> (Hancock)/<u>HB 3921</u> (Parker) - Relating to the financial exploitation of certain vulnerable adults. These bills arise primarily from elder abuse in financial situations. The measures have been pushed extensively by the AARP and consumer groups, and present a comprehensive solution. They are the product of interim studies and industry working groups, after extensive negotiation. The bills attempt to preempt a host of separate smaller bills on the subject.

Senate bill heard in B & C and left pending on 4/25. House bill passed the House on 5/4.

Class Action Waiver

<u>HB 4225</u> (Elkins) - Permits the waiver of a class action in a credit transaction or service contract.

Heard in Investments & Financial Services on 4/18 and left pending.

Credit Card Cyber Security

<u>SB 1409</u> (Menendez)/<u>HB 2333</u> (Elkins) - Pertains to the breach of security systems of businesses that expose consumer credit card or debit card information, and imposes civil penalties on the businesses breached. Pits the independent banks and credit unions against retail businesses retaining credit card information.

Senate bill referred to B & C. House bill heard and left pending in B & I on 4/24.

G -- Business Liability

Director Liability Following Charter Revocation

Section 171.255, Tax Code, is designed to enforce the collection of corporate taxes by the Comptroller. The tax collection tool, however, exposes directors and officers to an excessive liability for *all* corporate debts during a revocation period should taxes not be paid. <u>Hovel v. Batzri</u>, currently on appeal the Texas Supreme Court, supports a customary and reasonable approach as to when a debt is created under the statute. Should the Court, however, overturn the *Hovel* decision, there is concern that the uncertainty and negative impact of the statute could be significantly increased.

No bill filed. Awaiting action by the Texas Supreme Court.

Foreign Money Judgments

<u>SB 944</u> (Hughes)/<u>HB 2122</u> (Clardy) - Adopts the Uniform Foreign-Country Money Judgments Recognition Act.

Senate bill passed the Senate and referred to the House Judiciary & Civil Jurisprudence Committee. House bill heard in Judiciary & Civil Jurisprudence and placed on General State Calendar for today (5/5). BLS lawyer review indicates it is a good bill.

H -- Real Estate and Related Topics

Power of Attorney

<u>SB 926</u> (Rodriguez)/<u>HB 1974</u> (Wray) - Addresses significant modifications to the durable power of attorney provisions of Chapter 751, Estates Code, including mandatory acceptance.

The TBLF and REPTL consensus version, including the 10 day acceptance period, has become the operative version of the legislation. The TBA continues firm opposition. The Senate bill passed out of the State Affairs Committee on 4/20, and is pending on the Senate Intent Calendar. The committee substitute for the House bill passed out of the Judiciary & Civil Jurisprudence Committee and is set on the General State Calendar for 5/6.

I -- Taxation and Related Topics

Franchise Tax

Numerous bills pertaining to franchise tax reform, elimination, or cuts have been filed. <u>SB 17</u> (Nelson) - The designated Senate package for franchise tax change provides for a phased reduction and ultimate elimination, based on state revenue growth exceeding 5% during a biennium period. Advocates project that, based on current revenue estimates, the franchise tax would terminate in about 10 years under the bill.

Passed the Senate 3/21. Remains unreferred in the House.

<u>HB 28</u> (Bonnen) - The designated House package also provides for a phased reduction and elimination of the franchise tax, similar to SB 17, but using biennial budget balance certifications as the basis for rate reductions until elimination.

Passed the House on 4/28. Referred to Senate Finance.

Property Tax

The Senate leadership has declared property tax reform and cuts as key components of its legislative priorities. The House has made similar representations.

<u>SB 2</u> (Bettencourt) - The designated Senate package for ad valorem taxation reform, including an effective 4% cap on increases (triggers an automatic referendum).

Passed the Senate 3/22 and referred to Ways & Means on 4/19.

<u>HB 15</u> (Bonnen) - The comprehensive reform package proposed by the House. Also specifies an increase cap of 4%.

Referred to Ways and Means.

J -- Choice of Law

Application of Foreign and International Law

Efforts to restrict the impact in Texas courts of certain perceived repugnant foreign laws or doctrines continue. Bills could impact foreign judgment enforcement, use of foreign laws, and contractual choice of law and venue.

<u>HB 45</u> (Flynn) - Amends the Civil Practice and Remedies Code to prohibit application of foreign laws or contractual choice of law or venue provisions requiring foreign laws, if the foreign laws would violate rights under the U.S. or Texas constitutions.

The committee substitute voted out of committee limits the bill to family law matters and requires the Texas Supreme Court to develop related rules of practice. The bill is scheduled on the House Calendar for 5/5. <u>HB 498</u> (Fallon) - Amends the Family Code and narrows application to marriages and parent-child relationships.

Referred to Judiciary & Civil Jurisprudence.
