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# BUSINESS LAW SECTION STATE BAR OF TEXAS 85<sup>th</sup>TEXAS LEGISLATIVE SESSION FINAL REPORT

# June 12, 2017

The 140-day regular session of the 85th Legislature came to a raucous close on Monday, May 29<sup>th</sup>. Despite end-of-session flare-ups and disagreements over property tax reform, the bathroom privacy proposal, and sanctuary cities, the Texas Business Law Foundation (the "TBLF") enjoyed another very successful session. All four bills in the TBLF section-prepared package passed, along with a number of other business-related bills deemed favorable by the TBLF. All other legislation of concern was either amended satisfactorily or did not pass.

Again, the cornerstone of the TBLF's legislative success was the hard work and commitment of our Senate and House bill sponsors. In the Senate, Kelly Hancock (R-North Richland Hills), who took over this session as the chair of the Senate Business & Commerce Committee ("B&C"), carried the two BOC bills. Sen. Hancock's efforts and strong support of business law enhancement were critical and his work was complemented by excellent staff. The B&C staff was pivotal in the handling of the complete TBLF package.

Sen. Bryan Hughes (R-Mineola) carried the TUTSA bill and Sen. Craig Estes (R-Wichita Falls) carried the business names bill. We were pleased to develop working relationships with these two extremely capable members and their staffs on business law issues. Their work on these measures was outstanding.

On the House side, we were again grateful for the continued leadership of House Business & Industry Committee ("B&I") chair, Rene Oliveira (D-Brownsville), who carried the two BOC bills. This is his third session as chairman, and he has carried and overseen substantial TBLF legislative packages in each of the three sessions. In 2013, the TBLF presented Chairman Oliveira with its inaugural *Legislative Leadership Award* for his efforts in the significant

advancement of Texas business law. His dedication to improving the legal framework for Texas business has never wavered. We are indebted to him and his staff for the perseverance and hard work.

Longtime friend and TBLF supporter, Rep. Gary Elkins (R-Houston), chair of the Government Transparency and Operations committee, carried the TUTSA bill. As always, we are most appreciative to Chairman Elkins and his staff for their commitment and attention to TBLF issues.

We must especially acknowledge and thank Rep. Jason Villalba (R-Dallas) for his outstanding work on business issues generally, and his strong contribution in B&I. He has become the go-to expert on Texas business issues in committee and on the House floor, providing members with in-depth, dependable knowledge and guidance on business law topics and proposals. He carried the TBLF business names bill, and of course is the force behind the expanding Texas Chancery Court effort. His leadership and esteem in the Legislature continues to grow, and we are so fortunate to have him, and his staff, as a bold champion for TBLF initiatives and issues.

Finally, we thank Governor Abbott, Lt. Governor Patrick, and Speaker Straus for the continued support of business law initiatives and enhancements. The guidance and counsel provided by them, and their hardworking staffs, is invaluable in keeping Texas at the forefront of leading business states.

Again, all of these legislators and state officials are critical to our success. We encourage you individually, or through your firms and PACs, to remember them as the next election cycle starts. If possible, please keep us updated on any efforts in support of these important officeholders.

All in all, during the 85th regular session, lawmakers filed 7,002 bills and resolutions, and passed 1,314, an 18.8% pass ratio. In contrast, during the 84th session, there were 6,650 bills filed and 1,430 passed, with a 21.5% pass ratio. This constitutes a 5% increase in the number of bills filed, but a 9% decrease in bills passed. The Governor has until June 18<sup>th</sup> to approve or veto bills.

As previously reported, the Governor has called a special session to start on July 18th. Among the numerous issues to be considered, the Legislature will again attempt to address property tax reform. The lobby team will monitor all bills filed for business law relevance.

The BLS tracks legislation in ten (10) general subject-matter categories. Periodic updates come in two parts, the first part, below, is a summary of pertinent bill and issues within the categories. The second part contains a detailed list of all bills tracked within the categories.

# A -- Section Prepared Bills

Bills in this category are proposed by the TBLF.

# **Business Organization Code -- Corporations and Nonprofit Associations**

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee, addressing corporation, nonprofit corporation, and nonprofit association actions and matters, including share issuance, dividends, and ownership; director voting; mergers and conversions; defective act ratification; records transparency; and notice uniformity.

SB 1518 (Hancock)/HB 2827 (Oliveira) - SB 1518 is effective September 1.

# **Business Organization Code -- Partnerships and LLCs**

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee, affecting partnership, limited liability company, and series LLC actions and matters, including company and partnership agreement enforceability; officer vacancies; series LLC status; liability clarification; business names; service of process; records transparency; and winding up.

<u>SB 1517</u> (Hancock)/<u>HB 2826</u> (Oliveira) - SB 1517 is effective September 1.

## **Uniform Trade Secrets Act**

Amends the TUTSA, conforming it to the federal Defend Trade Secrets Act and recent case law.

<u>SB 1945</u> (Hughes)/<u>HB 1995</u> (Elkins) - HB 1995 is effective September 1.

#### **Business Names**

Replaces the current business name registration standard with the "distinguishable name" standard used in most other states, as supported by the Secretary of State.

<u>SB 1835</u> (Estes) /<u>HB 2856</u> (Villalba) - HB 2856 was signed by the Governor on 6/9. Effective June 1, 2018.

# B -- Business Courts

# **Chancery Court**

<u>HB 2594</u> (Villalba) - Establishes a dedicated business court system in Texas to handle specific business litigation.

The bill was filed by Rep. Villalba to continue momentum on the effort and to attempt development of a consensus by stakeholders. A series of stakeholder meetings and discussions were conducted during the session, which included the TBLF, TTLA, Judicial Council, and representatives from the Governor's office. The TBLF drafting team will continue development efforts during the interim. Rep. Villalba will seek an interim study charge on the issue and will continue meetings with the stakeholders.

# **C** -- Business Entities

#### Shareholder Oppression

For now, debate on the need to codify minority shareholder protections in the wake of <u>*Ritchie v. Rupe*</u> appears to have subsided. During the last legislative interim, B&I studied the issue, receiving pro and con testimony. Byron Egan, on behalf of the TBLF, presented compelling testimony that adequate remedies exist under current law and that additional codification on the subject is not needed, and likely would cause harmful uncertainty in business entity organization. B&I declined to make a recommendation on the issue.

No bill filed.

#### **Ethics/Interests in Government Contracts**

<u>HB 1295</u> (Capriglione) - Amendment package to previous enacted HB 1295 to clarify and simplify business entity compliance with required disclosures when contracting with a government entity. The bill increases the number of business entities exempt from the registration requirements (publicly traded entities and wholly owned subsidiaries; FDIC insured institutions; certain utilities; and insurance companies). Additionally, the bill re-defines several terms, including "contract," in ways that add confusion regarding the requirements and adds a civil penalty (\$500 for the first day; \$100 per day thereafter to a maximum of \$10,000) for an entity that fails to file the registration or the disclosures, enforceable by the Texas Ethics Commission or the Attorney General. Rep. Capriglione indicated a willingness to delete the penalty provisions.

Dead. See SB 255 below.

<u>HB 1610</u> (Kuempel) - An alternative amendment package to HB 1295. This bill initially would apply only to contracts in excess of \$10 million and simplifies the registration requirements. A proposed committee substitute drops the trigger to \$50,000, clarifies definitions, includes a list of exemptions similar to HB 1295, and doesn't include penalties.

Dead. See SB 255 below.

<u>SB 255</u> (Zaffirini) - Relating to contracts with and training for governmental entities and vendors, including purchasing and contract management training. An amendment was added in the House that included a section of HB 1295 eliminating disclosure requirements for publicly traded business entities and their wholly owned subsidiaries and gas/electric utilities. The amendment also revised the language of the required disclosure documentation for all other entities.

SB 255 was signed by the Governor on 6/9. Effective September 1, 2017.

#### **Health Organization Corporations and Partnerships**

<u>SB 679</u> (Hancock)/<u>HB 3820</u> (Dale) - Adds chiropractors to existing authorizations for doctors of medicine, osteopathy, and podiatry to establish business entities jointly owned and controlled by those types of practitioners.

SB 679 is effective immediately.

# Nonprofit Corporation Salary Disclosure

<u>HB 2674</u> (Uresti) - Adds Section 22.451 to the BOC, and requires nonprofits receiving 25% or more of income from state funding to file an annual report to the SOS showing employee and officer salaries. Efforts on various open government bills, HB 2328 and SB 408 (see the attached Tracking Report for text), could have a similar impact on NPCs. For now, it appears NPCs have escaped additional disclosure requirements, but the issue (and the ramifications from the *Greater Houston Partnership* case) will return next session.

Dead. See SCR 56 below.

<u>SCR 56</u> (Watson) - Requests the Lt. Governor and the Speaker to create a joint interim committee to examine all state open-government laws. The TBLF's NPC members will need to monitor this.

Passed. Pending before the Governor.

# **Benefit Corporations**

<u>HB 3488</u> (Hinojosa) - Relating to authorizing the formation of public benefit corporations. The bill was reworked for BOC compatibility, and is acceptable to the TBLF.

Passed. Pending before the Governor.

# **Nonprofit Corporation Audits**

<u>SB 2180</u> (Menéndez) - Provides an exemption for certain financial records from public inspection if a CPA has conducted an independent audit of any of the previous three fiscal years of a NPC's finances, so long as the NPC makes available to the public a copy of the audit letter and copies of its most recent three annual reports. Menendez's staff acknowledges drafting issues with the bill, and is open to suggestions. The staff advises the bill is an effort to better direct the use of limited NPC resources. Dead.

#### **SOS Termination of Business Entity**

<u>SB 1579</u> (Garcia) - Permits SOS to terminate the existence of a domestic filing entity if a substantial owner or governing person of the entity has been convicted of human trafficking or compelling prostitution. Garcia's staff acknowledges drafting issues with the bill, and is open to suggestions. The intent is to push ramifications for the criminal activity upward to businesses that might be involved.

Dead.

# <u>D -- UCC</u>

No bills filed.

# **E** -- Securities

#### Self Funding Status for State Securities Board

<u>HB 823</u> (Parker) - Gives the State Securities Board self-directed and semiindependent status, treating it similarly to the Texas Department of Banking.

Dead.

#### **Activist Shareholders**

<u>SB 2206</u> (Hancock) - A significantly shortened version Chairman Parker's "Bring Business to Texas and Disclosure Act" referenced below. Similarly imposes disclosure requirements for certain "activist" investor actions.

Dead. See HB 2382 below.

<u>HB 2382</u> (Parker) - The "Bring Business to Texas and Disclosure Act". Imposes extensive disclosure requirements for certain "activist" investor actions.

Dead. Discussion continues on interim study options, which Chairman Parker confirms will be requested. One suggestion is to establish an advisory panel of industry experts, rather than the customary standing legislative committee undertaking, or some combination of both. The TBLF will need to pay attention to this as the interim actions unfold.

#### **Insider Trading by Public Officials**

<u>HB 1090</u> (Meyer)/<u>SB 140</u> (V. Taylor) - Graduated increase in criminal penalties based on pecuniary gain, for public officials convicted of insider trading.

Both bills are dead.

#### F -- Financial Institutions

#### **Electronic Notarization**

<u>HB 1217</u> (Parker) - Establishes electronic notaries public. An initiative by the Texas Mortgage Bankers Association and others. A committee substitute contains a limited version of the bill, accommodating the SOS and major title companies.

Effective September 1.

#### **Texas Revised Uniform Fiduciary Access to Digital Assets**

<u>SB 1193</u> (V. Taylor)/<u>HB 2158</u> (Parker) - A REPTL initiative establishing procedures for the agreed administration of digital assets (electronic records in which individuals have rights or interests) by financial institutions. Review by impacted BLS lawyers indicates it's a good bill.

SB 1193 is effective September 1.

#### Usury

<u>HB 2977</u> (Longoria) - Relating to methods of computing interest charges on certain consumer loans.

Dead.

#### **Finance Agency Regulation**

Clarifies applicable law for licensees and others operating under the Finance Code.

<u>SB 1530</u> (Estes)/<u>HB 3081</u> (Capriglione) - Relating to the regulation of persons and business activities subject to regulation by certain finance agencies.

Both bills are dead.

# **Financial Exploitation**

<u>SB 2067</u> (Hancock)/<u>HB 3921</u> (Parker) - Relating to the financial exploitation of certain vulnerable adults. These bills arise primarily from elder abuse in financial situations. The measures have been pushed extensively by the AARP and consumer groups, and present a comprehensive solution. They are the product of interim studies and industry working groups, after extensive negotiation. The bills attempt to preempt a host of separate smaller bills on the subject.

HB 3921 is effective September 1.

#### **Class Action Waiver**

<u>HB 4225</u> (Elkins) - Permits the waiver of a class action in a credit transaction or service contract.

Dead.

# **Credit Card Cyber Security**

<u>SB 1409</u> (Menendez)/<u>HB 2333</u> (Elkins) - Pertains to the breach of security systems of businesses that expose consumer credit card or debit card information, and imposes civil penalties on the businesses breached. Pits the independent banks and credit unions against retail businesses retaining credit card information.

Both bills are dead.

# **G** -- Business Liability

#### **Director Liability Following Charter Revocation**

Section 171.255, Tax Code, is designed to enforce the collection of corporate taxes by the Comptroller. The tax collection tool, however, exposes directors and officers to excessive liability for *all* corporate debts during a revocation period should taxes not be paid. <u>Hovel</u> <u>v. Batzri</u>, currently on appeal the Texas Supreme Court, supports a customary and reasonable approach as to when a debt is created under the statute. Should the Court, however, overturn the *Hovel* decision, there is concern that the uncertainty and negative impact of the statute could be significantly increased.

No bill filed. Awaiting action by the Texas Supreme Court.

#### **Foreign Money Judgments**

<u>SB 944</u> (Hughes)/<u>HB 2122</u> (Clardy) - Adopts the Uniform Foreign-Country Money Judgments Recognition Act. BLS lawyer review indicates it is a good bill.

SB 944 is effective immediately.

#### H -- Real Estate and Related Topics

#### **Power of Attorney**

<u>SB 926</u> (Rodriguez)/<u>HB 1974</u> (Wray) - Addresses significant modifications to the durable power of attorney provisions of Chapter 751, Estates Code, including mandatory acceptance. The TBLF and REPTL consensus version is the final version of the bill, which includes a TLTA modification. The TBA has not ceased opposition.

HB 1974 is pending before the Governor.

# I -- Taxation and Related Topics

## **Franchise Tax**

Numerous bills pertaining to franchise tax reform, elimination, or cuts have been filed. <u>SB 17</u> (Nelson) - The designated Senate package for franchise tax change provides for a phased reduction and ultimate elimination, based on state revenue growth exceeding 5% during a biennium period.

Dead.

<u>HB 28</u> (Bonnen) - The designated House package also provides for a phased reduction and elimination of the franchise tax, similar to SB 17, but using biennial budget balance certifications as the basis for rate reductions until elimination.

Dead.

# **Property Tax**

The Senate leadership has declared property tax reform and cuts as key components of its legislative priorities. The House has made similar representations.

<u>SB 2</u> (Bettencourt) - The designated Senate package for ad valorem taxation reform, including an effective 5% cap on increases (triggers an automatic referendum).

Dead. Will be one of the subjects of the upcoming special session.

<u>SB 669</u> (Nelson) - Relating to the system for protesting or appealing certain ad valorem tax determinations. This bill has now become the vehicle for property tax reform, and contains much of HB 15, primarily transparency provisions minus the rollback cap modifications.

Dead. See SB 2 above.

<u>HB 15</u> (Bonnen) - The comprehensive reform package proposed by the House. Specifies an increase cap of 4%.

Dead. See SB 2 above.

# J -- Choice of Law

# Application of Foreign and International Law

Efforts to restrict the impact in Texas courts of certain perceived repugnant foreign laws or doctrines continue. Bills could impact foreign judgment enforcement, use of foreign laws, and contractual choice of law and venue.

<u>HB 45</u> (Flynn) - Amends the Civil Practice and Remedies Code to prohibit application of foreign laws or contractual choice of law or venue provisions requiring foreign laws, if the foreign laws would violate rights under the U.S. or Texas constitutions. The bill is limited to family law matters and requires the Texas Supreme Court to develop related rules of practice.

Pending before the Governor.

<u>HB 498</u> (Fallon) - Amends the Family Code and narrows application to marriages and parent-child relationships.

Dead.
