# BUSINESS LAW SECTION STATE BAR OF TEXAS TEXAS LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

April 9, 2021

On Tuesday, the Legislature returned from the short Easter break with a bang. A \$250B state budget passed the Senate. Abortion, medical marijuana, the Star Spangled Banner Protection Act, voter integrity/suppression (depending on your viewpoint), COVID liability limits, and broadband access, all received significant legislative attention, along with much of the TBLF agenda.

The session's committee hearing phase is now in full swing, with longer floor calendars materializing. Both the House and Senate have even conducted expedited, local and consent calendars. So the reality of the session, and the enormity of the tasks ahead is setting in.

Please continue to review bills in the SBOT Legislative Tracking Report categories of interest to you, and advise of concerns so that those bills can be moved to the overview section for more complete monitoring and possible action (as may be directed by the TBLF).

#### **A -- Section Prepared Bills**

Bills in this category are proposed by the TBLF.

#### **Business Organization Code – Omnibus Amendment Package**

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC, including general domestic entity updates and specific corporation, LLC, limited partnership, and REIT modifications. The package was developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

SB 1203 (Hancock)/HB 3364 (Turner) -- Relating to business entities.

SB passed Senate on 4/9
HB voted favorably from B&I on 4/8

Chairman Hancock, Chairman Turner, and the TBLF witness team, consisting of Daryl Robertson & Lorna Wassdorf (along with Elizabeth Miller & John Podvin remotely), did an outstanding job in the committee hearings. There was no significant feedback from committee members. Kevin Tipton and Traci Cotton from the SOS's office were available as resource witnesses, but not called.

#### **LLC Registered Series**

Provides for the use of protected and registered series by LLCs. The bill was also developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

SB 1523 (Hancock)/HB 3506 (Turner) -- Relating to registered and protected series of domestic limited liability companies; authorizing fees.

SB passed Senate on 4/9
HB voted favorably from B&I on 4/8

Again, Chairman Hancock, Chairman Turner, and the TBLF witness team, of Daryl Robertson & Lorna Wassdorf (along with Elizabeth Miller & John Podvin remotely), did an outstanding job. There was no feedback from committee members. Kevin Tipton and Traci Cotton from the SOS's office were again available as resource witnesses, but not called.

#### **Securities Act Corrections**

Technical amendments to the recodified Texas Securities Act deleting cross-references that confusingly could be construed to link TSA provisions that impose no duties on private actors to TSA private civil remedy provisions. Developed by the BLS Securities Committee, and approved by the SBOT Legislative Policy Committee and Board of Directors.

<u>SB 1280</u> (Hancock)/<u>HB 3443</u> (Anchia) -- Relating to certain provisions of the Securities Act for which a person offering or selling a security may be held liable to a person buying the security.

SB passed Senate on 4/9
HB voted favorably from PIFS on 4/9

Chairman Hancock, Chairman Anchia, and TBLF witness, Carol Mattick (along with John Fahy & John Podvin remotely), also provided an outstanding presentation. No pushback from committee members. The SSB was not required to provide resource information.

#### **B** -- Business Courts

#### **Texas Business Courts**

Endorsements from major trade associations and policy groups, the Governor's express recommendation, and strong development by the TBLF working committee (including the Villalba editorials and Tankersley memos) have given legislation for the creation of specialized Texas business courts a strong start. The Association of Corporate Counsel and the Texas Lawbook HB 1875 webinar/CLE, conducted on April 1<sup>st</sup> and coordinated by Irene Kosturakis and Mike Tankersley, provided an incredibly helpful and expansive forum, adding to the momentum. The webinar timing also ended up being quite good for the April 6<sup>th</sup> JCJ hearing.

<u>HB 1875</u> (Landgraf) -- Relating to the creation of the business court and the court of business appeals to hear certain cases; authorizing fees.

HB heard in JCJ on 4/6, left pending

Rep. Landgraf and the TBLF witness team consisting of Evan Young, Justice Tom Phillips, John Podvin, Brent Benoit, David Harrell, John Ale, and Mike Tankersley provided excellent advocacy for the JCJ lay-out of the bill. Opposition from TTLA was spearheaded by Jim Perdue, and supplemented with presentations from ABOTA by Grace Weatherly and Dan Richards. Interestingly, there was no testimony from the judges. In addition to the TBLF witness team, 12 support registrations, including major trade associations and policy groups, were received by JCJ for the bill. Only 1 against. Also, over 112 electronic statements on the bill were received by JCJ.

#### **Appellate Court Reapportionment**

This concept is another approach to impacting appellate court justice selection, particularly if more general proposals for judicial selection reform stall. The concept has been embraced by Lt. Gov. Patrick and is included in his legislative priority package.

SB 11 (Huffman)/HB 339 (King)/HB 2613 (Murr) -- The bill initially addressed the county make-ups of the 5th, 6th, and 12th Courts of Appeals, but has been significantly amended to decrease the number of appellate courts from 14 to 7.

SB voted favorably from Senate Jurisprudence Committee on 4/1 HB 339 referred to Redistricting Committee HB 2613 referred to Redistricting Committee

#### Texas Court of Appeals (Administrative Law Appeals)

<u>SB 1529</u> (Huffman) -- This initiative creates a new intermediary, statewide appeals court (5 justices elected statewide) focused exclusively on administrative action appeals, including state agency related cases. This is a spin-off from SB 11 reapportionment effort.

SB passed Senate Jurisprudence on 4/6

## **C -- Business Entities**

#### **Governing Persons or Officers**

<u>HB 514</u> (Beckley) -- Relating to repealing provisions prohibiting a physician assistant from serving as a governing person or officer of certain business entities.

HB referred to Public Health Committee

#### **Blockchain - Work Group**

SB 1076 (Paxton)/HB 1576 (Parker) -- Relating to the creation of a work group on blockchain matters concerning this state.

SB referred to B&C on 3/18
HB reported favorably in PIFS on 3/24
John Podvin and Ron Chichester provided support statements at the hearing, and a general TBLF support card was filed.

#### **Digital Identity - Work Group**

SB 1077 (Paxton)/HB 2199 (Parker) -- Relating to the establishment of the digital identity work group.

SB referred to B&C
HB reported favorably from State Affairs Committee 4/1

#### **Blockchain - UETA**

This measure is supported by the 'Texas Blockchain Council' ("TBC"), who is advancing Texas initiatives to blunt the aggressive crypto legal-landscape developing in Wyoming. See also **Virtual Currency** in the UCC section.

SB 344 (Paxton) -- Relating to the use of electronic signatures that employ blockchain or distributed ledger technology in certain business or governmental transactions, including related modifications to UETA. It appears a primary concern relates to state agency use (and the possible creation of unfunded mandates), where agency authority is questionable. Should the bill move, the TBC appears agreeable to removing the UETA changes, concurring with Professor Bill Henning that uniform laws remain technology agnostic. The remaining bill would address the state agency issue.

#### **SOS Filing Fee Exemption**

SB 938 (Campbell)/HB 1671 (Holland) -- Reinstates an exemption from the franchise tax and certain filing fees for certain businesses owned by veterans during an initial period of operation in the state.

SB passed Senate Finance Committee on 4/8 HB referred to Ways & Means Committee

# **Professional Entities: ESOP Ownership**

<u>HB 2246</u> (Shine) – Amends BOC Chapters 301 & 303, providing for employee-owned companies, related assistance programs, and contracting preferences. This is an initiative of an alliance of ESOPs to increase use, and is similar to Rep. Shine's bill from last session.

HB referred to State Affairs Committee

## **Business Purchase – Comptroller Tax Disclosure**

SB 873 (Hancock)/HB 3060 (Button) – Relating to disclosure by the comptroller to the purchaser of a business of the amount of tax due.

SB referred to House in Ways & Means Committee HB left pending in Ways & Means Committee

#### **Covenants Not To Compete – Discharged Employees**

<u>HB 1327</u> (Canales) – Relating to the enforceability of covenants not to compete against certain discharged employees. TBLF concerns with the bill have been communicated to Rep. Canales.

HB referred to B&I

#### **Covenants Not To Compete – Low-Wage Employees**

<u>HB 4290</u> (Hinojosa) -- Relating to a prohibition against covenants not to compete for certain low-wage employees.

HB referred to B&I

#### **Social Media Censorship**

SB 12 (Hughes)/HB 2587 (Sanford)/HB 3106 (Toth) -- Relating to the censorship of users' expressions by an interactive computer service.

SB referred to House State Affairs Committee on 4/6 HB action pending in State Affairs Committee HB referred to State Affairs Committee

# Social Media Censorship – Antitrust

<u>HB 3105</u> (Toth) – Relating to unlawful acts and practices of social media platforms.

HB referred to State Affairs Committee

## Social Media Censorship – State Contracts/Investments

<u>SB 1158</u> (Kolkhorst) -- Relating to state contracts with and investments in social media companies that censor political speech.

SB heard in State Affairs on 4/6, left pending

#### **NPCs – Government Contracts**

<u>HB 3100</u> (Campos) -- Relating to requirements for governmental contracts with nonprofit organizations regarding the use of money provided under those contracts.

HB referred to State Affairs Committee

#### **NPCs – Donor Information**

SB 1678 (Campbell)/HB 4275 (Klick) -- Relating to the prohibited release by a public agency of information regarding the members, supporters, or volunteers of or donors to certain nonprofit organizations; creating a criminal offense.

SB voted favorably from State Affairs Committee on 4/6, left pending HB referred to State Affairs Committee

#### **BODs: Mandated Female Directors**

This issue returns, along with related constitutional concerns and prospective actions by NASDAQ.

SB 1634 (Miles)/HB 4070 (Minjarez) -- Relating to requiring female representation on the boards of directors of certain publicly traded corporations; authorizing administrative penalties.

SB referred to B&C on 3/24 HB referred to B&I on 3/29

#### **BODs: Civil Rights Laws**

<u>SB 2118</u> (Hughes) -- Relating to ensuring compliance with federal civil-rights laws by corporations doing business in Texas, and prohibiting discrimination in the selection of a corporation's board members.

SB referred to State Affairs Committee

## **Certificates of Formation – Address**

<u>HB 3131</u> (Cole) -- Relating to the information required to be included in the certificate of formation of a filing entity. Requires a "preferred mailing address". TBLF concerns with the bill have been communicated to Rep. Cole, who has advised the bill was requested by the Comptroller.

HB voted favorably from B&I on 4/8

# **Corporate Privileges Termination - Environmental Disasters**

This initiative presents numerous concerns, including 'why aren't existing penalties and remedies adequate', recourse against and corrective actions by offending entities could be impeded, 'piercing the veil' issues, insurance coverage blocked, and applicable federal programs frustrated.

<u>HB 3477</u> (Rose) -- Relating to the termination of corporate privileges for certain business entities under enforcement action for a violation of environmental laws. TBLF concerns have been communicated to Rep. Rose, who advises that the bill is in response to an environmental problem in her Southeast Dallas district.

# Oil & Gas Companies - Boycott Prevention

<u>SB 13</u> (Birdwell) -- Relating to contracts with and investments in companies that boycott certain energy companies.

SB voted favorably from Natural Resources/Economic Development Committee on 4/8

#### Critical Infrastructure Contracts - Certain Foreign-Owned Company Prohibitions

<u>HB 4359</u> (Parker)/<u>SB 2116</u> (Campbell) -- Relating to prohibiting contracts or other agreements with certain foreign-owned companies in connection with critical infrastructure in this state.

HB scheduled for hearing on 4/14 at 8:00 a.m. in House State Affairs SB referred to B&C

#### D -- UCC

#### Oil & Gas - Lien Perfection

This effort addresses the *First River Energy* case, and entails amendments to UCC Chapter 9. The initiative is spearheaded by the Texas Land & Mineral Owners Association ("TLMOA"), and enjoys producer support.

SB 1468 (Hinojosa)/HB 3794 (Geren) – Relating to oil and gas liens. Adds new Chapter 67 to the Property Code to govern certain oil & gas liens, essentially restoring the priority of oil & gas interest owners and producers over first purchasers of production. It tangentially amends UCC 9.203 and repeals UCC 9.343. The BLS UCC Committee questions the UCC 9.203 modification, and advises the modification will adversely impact oil & gas lending transactions. Karen Neeley and Daryl Robertson, along with financial institution representatives, have proposed perfecting amendments to the bill, which have been tentatively agreed to by TLMOA.

SB referred to Natural Resources and Economic Development Committee HB voted favorably from House Energy Resources on 4/1

#### Virtual Currency

The TBC has proposed crypto-currency related amendments to UCC Chapters 1 and 9 to enhance Texas as an attractive state for crypto industry development. Texas A&M law Professor Bill Henning (NCCUSL & ALI) has weighed-in on the blockchain and crypto debate as it relates to the UCC, along with Texas banking groups, to urge restraint so as to not inadvertently impact general financial application of the UCC. It's noted that a proposed new UCC chapter governing the subject will be released within the next year. John Podvin, Karen Neely, and John Fleming have been extensively involved in these discussions. See also **Blockchain - UETA** in the Business Entities section.

<u>HB 4474</u> (Parker) -- Relating to the control of virtual currency and the rights of purchasers who obtain control of virtual currency for purposes of the Uniform Commercial Code. The bill amends UCC 9 to accomplish this.

HB scheduled for hearing on 04/14 in PIFS

The bill as introduced was reworked to narrowly focus on virtual currency only. Review by banking groups and the BLS UCC Committee continues, but a proposal to create a new UCC 12 (within the bill) is under consideration. The new chapter would be a precursor to the actual NCCUSL version on the subject currently under development nationally.

# Registered Securities Market Operators/Securities Transactions/Derivative Contracts - Taxation

<u>HB 3702</u> (Paddie)/<u>SB 2001</u> (Springer) -- Relating to prohibiting the enactment of a law that imposes a tax on certain transactions that either convey a security or involve specified derivative contracts.

HB reported favorably from House in Ways & Means on 4/6 SB referred to Finance Committee

<u>SJR 67</u> (Springer)/<u>HJR 140</u> (Paddie) -- Proposing a constitutional amendment prohibiting the enactment of a law that imposes a tax on certain transactions that either convey a security or involve specified derivative contracts.

SJR referred to Finance Committee
HJR reported favorably from Ways & Means Committee on 4/8

#### State Securities Board – Self-Directed Status

<u>HB 4131</u> (Parker) -- Relating to the self-directed and semi-independent status of the State Securities Board; authorizing fees.

HB referred to PIFS

#### **Rule Against Perpetuities**

SB 1377 (Johnson)/HB 654 (Lucio) – Provides for a 300-year vesting period.

<u>HB 4164</u> (Capriglione) -- Relating to the authority of individuals over the personal identifying information collected, processed, or maintained about the individuals and certain others by certain businesses.

This is the proposed comprehensive Texas Pandemic Response Act, which separates pandemics from general Government Code provisions addressing emergency management and disasters, and addresses pandemic liability shields for businesses.
