# BUSINESS LAW SECTION STATE BAR OF TEXAS 87th TEXAS LEGISLATIVE SESSION FINAL REGULAR SESSION REPORT

May 31, 2021

The Regular Session of the 87th Legislature adjourned *Sine Die* today, ending one of the most unusual sessions ever. Starting with an essential lock-down because of the pandemic along with fallout from the Presidential election, then a restructuring of the House with the election of a new Speaker, and then stunned by Winter Storm Uri, the Legislature appeared to retrench for a focused, minimal course to primarily address emergency needs and the budget. What evolved was something quite different, and ended with a quorum-busting walkout by House Democrats, with multiple special sessions and vetoes threatened.

Prompting the session's shift from the opening minimalism was an aggressive dive by Republicans into numerous hot-button issues and the perceived impact on the next election cycle. The shift found Rs enjoying considerable success with numerous ultra-conservative issues, but not all. They ended the session clamoring for more action via an immediate special session. Democrats on the other hand, fatigued with repeated defensive losses, could not get out of the Capitol fast enough. Which they in fact did on Sunday evening with the walkout, procedurally killing several remaining R initiatives.

The stressfull legislative action interestingly brought some late session deterioration in the working relationship between the Lt. Governor and the Speaker. That said, each still carried out their roles effectively and definitively, significantly accomplishing their stated agendas.

Despite the obstacles and anger, the session managed many successes. The initial issues...the pandemic, the Winter Storm, and the budget...brought non-partisan working unity, and were significantly addressed, as were most of the Governor's emergency issues.

A 30-day special session now looms for redistricting, and likely more. The projected start date for the session remains sometime in September, but at the moment lots of rumors are flying.

In the midst of everything, the Texas Business Law Foundation enjoyed another successful session. All 3 bills in the TBLF Section Prepared package passed, along with a number of other business-related bills deemed favorable by the TBLF. All other legislation of concern was either amended satisfactorily or did not pass.

Again, the cornerstone of the TBLF's legislative success was the hard work and commitment of our Senate and House bill sponsors. In the Senate, Kelly Hancock (R-North Richland Hills), chairman of the Business & Commerce Committee, continued his strong support for business law issues by carrying the entire TBLF package. His efforts (enhanced by his great staff) were critical to the TBLF success.

On the House side, we were pleased to start a new TBLF relationship with the incoming chair of the Business & Industry Committee, Rep. Chris Turner (D-Grand Prairie), who carried 2 TBLF bills. He did an outstanding job in quickly moving the bills, in coordination with Sen. Hancock. We are indebted to him and his staff for the focus and hard work, particularly in light of his all-consuming role as chairman of the House Democratic caucus. We were also pleased to work with the new chair of the Pensions, Investments & Financial Services Committee, Rep. Rafael Anchia (D-Dallas), who carried the 3<sup>rd</sup> bill in the package. Similarly, Chairman Anchia and his team provided appreciated leadership and effectiveness in successfully moving the legislation.

The specialized business courts effort continued this session with significant advancement, but unfortunately not to the level of passage. We appreciated the efforts of sponsor, Rep. Brooks Landgraf (R-Odessa), in undertaking a strong leadership position and moving the bill further than any prior session. We also appreciated the support from cosponsors Rep. Jeff Leach (R-Plano), Rep. Greg Bonnen (R-Friendswood), and Rep. Reggie Smith (R-Van Alstyne). The Governor's continuing support, of course, was vital. All of these efforts pushed the issue to the next level of awareness and acceptability within the legislative process.

Finally, as always, we must acknowledge Governor Abbott, Lt. Governor Patrick, and Speaker Phelen for their overarching support of business law initiatives. The guidance and counsel provided by them, and their staffs, is fundamental to TBLF achievements and the overall effort to keep Texas at the forefront of leading business states.

Again, all of these legislators and state officials are critical to our success. We encourage you to remember them as the election cycle starts. If possible, please keep us informed on efforts in support of these important officeholders.

All in all, during the 87<sup>th</sup> Regular Session, lawmakers filed 7,327 bills and resolutions, and passed 705, for just under a 10% pass ratio. This is an unusually low output...about ½ the norm,

but was expected. In contrast, during the 86<sup>th</sup> Session, lawmakers filed 7,795 bills and resolutions, and passed 1,564, for a 20% pass ratio. A pass ratio of approximately 20% (before vetoes) has predominated in recent prior sessions. The Governor has until June 20<sup>th</sup> to approve or veto bills.

#### **A -- Section Prepared Bills**

Bills in this category are proposed by the TBLF.

#### **Business Organization Code – Omnibus Amendment Package**

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC, including general domestic entity updates and specific corporation, LLC, limited partnership, and REIT modifications. The package was developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

SB 1203 (Hancock)/HB 3364 (Turner) -- Relating to business entities.

SB passed Legislature, signed by Governor, effective 9/1

#### **LLC Registered Series**

Provides for the use of protected and registered series by LLCs. The bill was also developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

<u>SB 1523</u> (Hancock)/<u>HB 3506</u> (Turner) -- Relating to registered and protected series of domestic limited liability companies; authorizing fees.

SB passed Legislature, signed by Governor, effective 6/1/22

#### **Securities Act Corrections**

Technical amendments to the recodified Texas Securities Act deleting cross-references that confusingly could be construed to link TSA provisions that impose no duties on private actors to TSA private civil remedy provisions. Developed by the BLS Securities Committee, and approved by the SBOT Legislative Policy Committee and Board of Directors.

SB 1280 (Hancock)/HB 3443 (Anchia) -- Relating to certain provisions of the Securities Act for which a person offering or selling a security may be held liable to a person buying the security.

SB passed Legislature, signed by the Governor, effective 1/1/22

#### **B** -- Business Courts

#### **Texas Business Courts**

Endorsements from major trade associations and policy groups; the Governor's express recommendation and support; strong outreach and development by the TBLF working committee; the ACC/Texas Lawbook webinar orchestrated by Irene Kosturakis and Mike Tankersley; the strong performance by the TBLF witness team (Evan Young, Justice Tom Phillips, John Podvin, Brent Benoit, David Harrell, John Ale, and Mike Tankersley); and the internal SBOT advocacy by Frank Ruttenberg and Ron Chichester, all combined to substantially increase awareness and push efforts to create specialized Texas business courts to their strongest level yet. And of course, special thanks go to Jason Villalba for initiating the effort during his tenure in the House, and his continued guidance and assistance this session. Despite the set-back with HB 1875, the initiative's chances for future success have been greatly enhanced.

<u>HB 1875</u> (Landgraf) -- Relating to the creation of the business court and the court of business appeals to hear certain cases; authorizing fees. JCJ Chairman Jeff Leach, Appropriations Chairman Greg Bonnen, and JCJ member Rep. Reggie Smith joined Chairman Landgraf as joint-sponsors.

Dead. Efforts will continue.

#### **Appellate Court Reapportionment**

This concept is another approach to impacting appellate court justice selection, particularly if more general proposals for judicial selection reform stall. The concept has been embraced by Lt. Gov. Patrick and is included in his legislative priority package.

SB 11 (Huffman)/HB 339 (King)/HB 2613 (Murr) -- The bill initially addressed the county make-ups of the 5th, 6th, and 12th Courts of Appeals, but has been significantly amended to decrease the number of appellate courts.

#### Texas Court of Appeals (Administrative Law Appeals)

This initiative creates a new intermediary, statewide appeals court (5 justices elected statewide) focused exclusively on administrative action appeals, including state agency related cases. This is a spin-off from SB 11 reapportionment effort.

<u>SB 1529</u> (Huffman) -- Relating to the creation of the Texas Court of Appeals to hear certain cases; authorizing fees.

#### **C – BUSINESS ENTITIES**

#### **Governing Persons or Officers**

<u>HB 514</u> (Beckley) -- Relating to repealing provisions prohibiting a physician assistant from serving as a governing person or officer of certain business entities.

Dead

#### **Blockchain - Work Group**

SB 1076 (Paxton)/HB 1576 (Parker) -- Relating to the creation of a work group on blockchain matters concerning this state.

HB passed Legislature, sent to Governor on 5/26

TBLF support statements were filed at the committee hearings.

#### **Digital Identity - Work Group**

SB 1077 (Paxton)/HB 2199 (Parker) -- Relating to the establishment of the digital identity work group.

SB dead HB dead

#### **Blockchain - UETA**

This measure is supported by the 'Texas Blockchain Council' ("TBC"), who is advancing Texas initiatives to blunt the aggressive crypto legal-landscape developing in Wyoming. See also **Virtual Currency** in the UCC section.

SB 344 (Paxton) -- Relating to the use of electronic signatures that employ blockchain or distributed ledger technology in certain business or governmental transactions, including related modifications to UETA. It appears a primary concern relates to state agency use (and the possible creation of unfunded mandates), where agency authority is questionable. The TBC was agreeable to removing the UETA changes, concurring with Professor Bill Henning that certain uniform laws remain technology agnostic.

#### **SOS Filing Fee Exemption**

SB 938 (Campbell)/HB 1671 (Holland) -- Reinstates an exemption from the franchise tax and certain filing fees for certain businesses owned by veterans during an initial period of operation in the state.

#### SB passed Legislature, sent to Governor on 5/27

#### **Professional Entities: ESOP Ownership**

<u>HB 2246</u> (Shine) – Amends BOC Chapters 301 & 303, providing for employee-owned companies, related assistance programs, and contracting preferences. This is an initiative of an alliance of ESOPs to increase use, and is similar to Rep. Shine's bill from last session.

#### **Business Purchase – Comptroller Tax Disclosure**

SB 873 (Hancock)/HB 3060 (Button) – Relating to disclosure by the comptroller to the purchaser of a business of the amount of tax due.

SB passed Legislature, sent to Governor on 5/26

#### **Covenants Not To Compete – Discharged Employees**

<u>HB 1327</u> (Canales) – Relating to the enforceability of covenants not to compete against certain discharged employees. TBLF concerns with the bill were communicated to Rep. Canales.

#### **Covenants Not To Compete – Low-Wage Employees**

<u>HB 4290</u> (Hinojosa) -- Relating to a prohibition against covenants not to compete for certain low-wage employees.

#### **Social Media Censorship**

SB 12 (Hughes)/HB 2587 (Sanford)/HB 3106 (Toth) -- Relating to the censorship of users' expressions by an interactive computer service.

#### Social Media Censorship - Antitrust

<u>HB 3105</u> (Toth) – Relating to unlawful acts and practices of social media platforms.

Dead

#### Social Media Censorship – State Contracts/Investments

SB 1158 (Kolkhorst) -- Relating to state contracts with and investments in social media companies that censor political speech.

Dead

#### **NPCs – Government Contracts**

<u>HB 3100</u> (Campos) -- Relating to requirements for governmental contracts with nonprofit organizations regarding the use of money provided under those contracts.

Dead

#### **NPCs – Donor Information**

<u>SB 1678</u> (Campbell)/<u>HB 4275</u> (Klick) -- Relating to the prohibited release by a public agency of information regarding the members, supporters, or volunteers of or donors to certain nonprofit organizations; creating a criminal offense.

SB dead HB dead

#### **BODs: Mandated Female Directors**

This issue returns, along with related constitutional concerns and prospective actions by NASDAQ.

SB 1634 (Miles)/HB 4070 (Minjarez) -- Relating to requiring female representation on the boards of directors of certain publicly traded corporations; authorizing administrative penalties.

#### **BODs: Civil Rights Laws**

SB 2118 (Hughes) -- Relating to ensuring compliance with federal civil-rights laws by corporations doing business in Texas, and prohibiting discrimination in the selection of a corporation's board members.

Dead

#### Certificates of Formation – Address

<u>HB 3131</u> (Cole) -- Relating to the information required to be included in the certificate of formation of a filing entity. Requires a "preferred mailing address". TBLF concerns with the bill have been communicated to Rep. Cole and the

Comptroller. The Comptroller advises the bill is needed in connection with tax notices.

Passed Legislature, on way to Governor

The bill was amended to address TBLF concerns, including changing "preferred mailing address" to "initial mailing address".

#### **Corporate Privileges Termination - Environmental Disasters**

This initiative presented numerous business law concerns, including 'why aren't existing penalties and remedies adequate', recourse against and corrective actions by offending entities could be impeded, 'piercing the veil' issues, insurance coverage blocked, and applicable federal programs frustrated.

<u>HB 3477</u> (Rose) -- Relating to the termination of corporate privileges for certain business entities under enforcement action for a violation of environmental laws. TBLF concerns were communicated to Rep. Rose, who advised the bill is in response to the 'Shingle Mountain' catastrophe in southeast Dallas.

#### Oil & Gas Companies - Boycott Prevention

SB 13 (Birdwell)/ HB 2189 (King) -- Relating to contracts with and investments in companies that boycott certain energy companies.

SB passed Legislature, on way to Governor

#### Critical Infrastructure Contracts – Certain Foreign-Owned Company Prohibitions

SB 2116 (Campbell)/HB 4359 (Parker) -- Relating to prohibiting contracts or other agreements with certain foreign-owned companies in connection with critical infrastructure in this state.

SB passed Legislature, on way to Governor

#### Gun Industry Discrimination – Government Contracting Disclosure and Restrictions

SB 19 (Schwertner)/ HB 2558 (Capriglione) -- Relating to prohibited contracts with companies that discriminate against the firearm or ammunition industries. Applies to all contracts between government entities and companies with at least 10 full-time employees and 'a value of at least \$100,000'. Requires written verification within contracts.

SB passed Legislature, on way to Governor

#### **Assumed Name Certificates**

Amends chapter 71, Business & Commerce Code, impacting prior TBLF legislative initiatives.

<u>SB 2160</u> (Menendez) – Relating to the filing of an assumed name certificate by certain business entities.

Dead

#### D – UCC

#### Oil & Gas - Lien Perfection

This effort addresses the *First River Energy* case, and entails amendments to UCC Chapter 9. The initiative is spearheaded by the Texas Land & Mineral Owners Association ("TLMOA"), and enjoys producer support.

SB 1468 (Hinojosa)/HB 3794 (Geren) – Relating to oil and gas liens. Adds new Chapter 67 to the Property Code to govern certain oil & gas liens, essentially restoring the priority of oil & gas interest owners and producers over first purchasers of production. It repeals UCC 9.343 and initially amended UCC 9.203. The BLS UCC Committee questioned the UCC 9.203 modification, and advised the modification would adversely impact oil & gas lending transactions. An amendment resolving the concern was added to the bill.

HB passed Legislature, sent to Governor on 5/22

#### **Virtual Currency**

The TBC has proposed crypto-currency related amendments to UCC Chapters 1 and 9 to enhance Texas as an attractive state for crypto industry development. Texas A&M law Professor Bill Henning (NCCUSL & ALI) has weighed-in on the blockchain and crypto debate as it relates to the UCC, along with Texas banking groups, to urge restraint so as to not inadvertently impact general financial application of the UCC. It's noted that a proposed new UCC chapter governing the subject will be released within the next year. See also **Blockchain - UETA** in the Business Entities section.

<u>HB 4474</u> (Parker) -- Relating to the control of virtual currency and the rights of purchasers who obtain control of virtual currency for purposes of the Uniform Commercial Code.

Passed Legislature, on way to Governor

Efforts by banking groups, the BLS UCC Committee, and Professor Henning resulted in amendments to the bill, essentially moving the virtual currency content to a new UCC 12. Professor Henning believes the new chapter is an acceptable precursor to the anticipated NCCUSL version.

#### **E** -- Securities

### Registered Securities Market Operators/Securities Transactions/Derivative Contracts – Taxation

SB 2001 (Springer)/HB 3702 (Paddie) -- Relating to prohibiting the enactment of a law that imposes a tax on certain transactions that either convey a security or involve specified derivative contracts.

<u>SJR 67</u> (Springer)/<u>HJR 140</u> (Paddie) -- Proposing a constitutional amendment prohibiting the enactment of a law that imposes a tax on certain transactions that either convey a security or involve specified derivative contracts.

<u>HB 4131</u> (Parker) -- Relating to the self-directed and semi-independent status of the State Securities Board; authorizing fees.

#### **Rule Against Perpetuities**

SB 1377 (Johnson)/HB 654 (Lucio) – Provides for a 300-year vesting period.

#### M & M Liens

<u>HB 2237</u> (Burrows) – Relating to mechanic's, contractor's, or materialman's liens. Chairman Burrows advises all stakeholders are now in agreement on this long-attempted effort.

Passed Legislature, on way to Governor

#### **Agreed Exchange Mediums**

<u>HJR 100</u> (Parker) – Proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the right to own, hold and use any mutually agreed upon medium of exchange.

Dead

<u>SJR 55</u> (Creighton) -- Proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the right to own, hold, and use any mutually agreed upon medium of exchange.

Dead

#### **Biometric Identifiers**

<u>HB 1977</u> (Parker) – Relating to the applicability of certain limitations on the capture and use of biometric identifiers in financial institutions.

Dead

#### **Biometric Identifiers: Personal Identifying Information**

<u>HB 4164</u> (Capriglione) -- Relating to the authority of individuals over the personal identifying information collected, processed, or maintained about the individuals and certain others by certain businesses.

#### Savings & Mortgage Lending Commissioner – Authority

<u>SB 1900</u> (Zaffirini)/<u>HB 4309</u> (Anchia) -- Relating to the regulatory authority of the savings and mortgage lending commissioner; authorizing fees.

SB passed Legislature, on way to Governor

#### **Credit Union Department/Credit Union Commission -- Sunset**

SB 707 (Paxton)/HB 1840 (Lambert) -- Relating to the continuation and functions of the Credit Union Department and the Credit Union Commission.

SB passed Legislature, sent to Governor on 5/20

#### **G** -- Choice of Law

No bills were identified from the SBOT Track.

#### H -- Business Liability

#### **Government Official Insider Trading**

<u>HB 1595</u> (Meyer) – Relating to increasing the criminal penalties for insider trading and other misuse of official information.

Dead

#### **Pandemic Liability Shield**

<u>HB 3</u> (Burrows) – Relating to state and local government responses to a pandemic disaster. This is the proposed comprehensive Texas Pandemic Response Act, which separates pandemics from general Government Code provisions addressing emergency management and disasters, and addresses pandemic liability shields for businesses.

SB 6 (Hancock)/HB 3659 (Leach) -- Relating to liability for certain claims arising during a pandemic or other disaster or emergency. This is the primary liability shield bill.

#### Franchise Tax - LLCs

<u>HB 2704</u> (Morrison) -- This initiative permits classification of certain LLCs as passive entities (similar to partnerships) for exemption from franchise taxes. The effort continues from last session.
